

ORDINANCE NO. 243

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF TINICUM, BUCKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA CREATING A SPEED LIMIT OF 35 MPH ON CAFFERTY ROAD (T-440) BETWEEN TORY ROAD (T-409) AND THREE-TENTHS OF A MILE NORTH OF RIVER ROAD (SR. 0032) WHERE THE SPEED LIMIT IS REDUCED TO 25 MPH

WHEREAS, the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code authorizes local officials to establish maximum speed limits on roads within their jurisdiction following an engineering and traffic study; and

WHEREAS, an engineering and traffic study was conducted by the Tinicum Township Police in accordance with Pennsylvania Department of Transportation Regulations that confirmed that the speed limit on Cafferty Road (T-440) between Tory Road (T-409) and three-tenths of a mile north of River Road (SR 0032) where the speed limit is reduced to 25 MPH should be reduced to 35 MPH; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors believes establishing a maximum speed limit on Cafferty Road (T-440) between Tory Road (T-409) and three-tenths of a mile north of River Road (SR 0032) where the speed limit is reduced to 25 MPH is in the best interest of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of Tinicum Township and the travelling public.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it, and it is hereby ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Tinicum Township, Bucks County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ENACTED and ORDAINED by authority of same as follows:

ARTICLE I. The Board of Supervisors of Tinicum Township establishes the maximum speed limit in accordance with 75 P.S. §6109(a)(10) on the following road:

STREET

BETWEEN

MAXIMUM SPEED LIMIT

Cafferty Road (T-440)

Tory Road (T-409) and
three-tenths of a mile
north of River Road (SR 0032)
where the speed limit is
reduced to 25 MPH

35 MPH

ARTICLE II. The appropriate Township officials are hereby authorized to erect the required traffic control signs and devices necessary to identify the maximum speed limit established by this Ordinance.




ARTICLE IV. This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days following its legal enactment.


