ORDINANCE NO. 253

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF TINICUM, BUCKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 185 AMENDING ORDINANCE 14, AS AMENDED, TRAFFIC REGULATIONS, TO ESTABLISH WEIGHT RESTRICTION AND WIDTH RESTRICTIONS FOR VEHICLES UTILIZING THE DIRT & GRAVEL ROADS IN TINICUM TOWNSHIP.

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Tincum Township adopted Ordinance No. 185 establishing weight and width restrictions for vehicles utilizing dirt and gravel roads within the Township; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Tincum Township has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of Tincum Township to repeal Ordinance No. 185.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it, and it is hereby **ORDAINED** by the Board of Supervisors of Tincum Township, Bucks County, Pennsylvania, that Ordinance No. 185 amending Ordinance 14, as amended, Traffic Regulations, to establish weight restrictions and width restrictions for vehicles utilizing the Dirt & Gravel Roads in Tincum Township is hereby **REPEALED**, effective September 30, 2021.


