

ORDINANCE NO. 258

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF TINICUM, BUCKS COUNTY
PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING THE TRAFFIC REGULATIONS TO CREATE A 25
MPH SPEED LIMIT ON SHERMAN ROAD BETWEEN DURHAM ROAD AND
HEADQUARTERS ROAD.**

WHEREAS, the use and location of certain roadways within the Township of Tinicum are such as to require the regulation of traffic thereon; and

WHEREAS, the Tinicum Township Police Department conducted a traffic study in May of 2022 and determined that the existing speed limit of 55 MPH on Sherman Road is excessive and constitutes a traffic hazard; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the protection, preservation, and maintenance of the health, welfare and safety of the citizens of Tinicum Township for the Board of Supervisors to establish Sherman Road as a Residence District and to reduce the speed limit on this road to the twenty-five (25) miles per hour.

NOW THEREFORE, the Board of Supervisors of Tinicum Township hereby establishes a speed limit of twenty-five (25) miles per hour on Sherman Road (T-424) from its intersection with Durham Road to its junction with Headquarters Road in accordance with 75 Pa. CSA § 6109 (a)(14) and 67 Pa. Code§ 201.31.

ENACTED AND ORDAINED this ^{6th} day of ^{December} 2022. This amendment to the Traffic Regulations shall become effective five (5) days after its adoption.
