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GENERAL WELL STANDARDS (see Ordinance 123 for more information)

Upon completion of the installation of any well, the owner of the premises upon which the well has been installed shall produce a certificate of potability for water within the well, a certificate setting forth the rate of flow of water from the well, and information stating the depth to water and the geologic description. In addition, the quality of the water produced by the well shall be tested to determine compliance with the following maximum contaminant limits by a Water Quality Laboratory certified by the Dept. of Environmental Protection of the Commonwealth of PA:

A certificate indicating a representative sample of the well water was taken by the Testing Laboratory and compliance or lack of compliance of the well water (specifying each contaminant which does not comply) shall be supplied to the Township together with the application for an occupancy permit not more than 30 days prior to occupancy.

No occupancy permit will be issued for any lot unless the lot contains a well which has a production of not less than 5 gallons per minute as established by the bailer test or an equivalent test satisfactory to the Township and unless the water quality of the well meets the aforementioned standards or standards.
